



Situate in the River Susquehanna in the Township of Canastotoe and County of Lancaster
 Caled "Rockey Island." Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrent dated the tenth day of November A.D.
 1803 granted to John Kindig and Philip Urban, the Courses and distances are as Follows
 Viz! Beginning at this  Mark in the above diagram thence Extending down the River South
 forty six Degrees East four Perches South eighty one degrees East nineteen perches thence
 up the River North forty five degrees West fourteen perches and seven tenth and South
 Sixty nine degrees West twelve perches and a half to the Place of Beginning Containing an
 half an Acre and the usual Allowance of six p^c. being Between Eshleman's Falls & Canasto-
 toe Island and about Two Hundred & fifty yards below and Island (said) Improved by George
 & Lewis Urban and Israel Nestelroth. Nov^r. 15th 1803
