

Note:- The records show that a warrant was granted to E.P. Darlington Aug. 1, 1860 for 100 acres of the bed of the Ohio River. This was surveyed Aug. 25, 1860 and seems to include the land in question. Also that this tract and all the remainder of this Back Channel is covered by the survey returned for D.J. Kyle, Alex. S. Hunter, Geo. H. Clapp, and F. M. Love Dec. 30, 1899.

A Draft of a tract of land situated in the Township of Neville and County of Allegheny, containing one (1) acre, 137.21 perches. Surveyed the twenty-seventh day of January 1902 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Robert H. Hamilton dated the fifteenth day of January 1902.
