Being parts of a larger tract of Land Originally Surveyed by G. Stevenson late D.S. on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of December A.D. 1755 in Pursuance of two Warrants for 100 acres each, both dated the 8<sup>th</sup> day of May A.D. 1742 Granted to Baltzer Knartzer alias Palzer Knertzer. And afterwards resurveyed and Divided off from the said larger tract by Jacob Spangler late D.S. And now on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of November 1826 the same has been calculated, examined &c. and found to be correct, and at the request of the present owners returned for confirmation.
