The improvements are a small Log-house and Stable with about 8 Acres of cleared land, first commenced about 3 Years ago by Doctor John Rose the son in law of Jeremiah Klinger, who requested that his improvement should be included in his father in law's survey. * The warrant authorising John Bechtols survey, came to my hands on Monday the 25th July 1825. no entry of either warrant or survey having been previously made by the former deputy altho' regularly received and executed by him.
