



Richard Saunders Sold to James Lowms three Sev'l Lots w^{ch} are part of Barth: Coppacks & part of Thomas Powell's Lots & are bounded as here shewed by the ^{ick} pad lines. In pursuance of a Warrt from the proprietaries dated the first day of May 1738. Resurv^d on the 8th of the same Month unto James Lowms the ground bought of R. Saunders in three pieces in all being 44 1/2 ft. front & 300 ft. in length of w^{ch} breadth 17 1/2 ft. is part of Bart. Coppack's Lot & 27 ft. is part of T. Powells Lot. Returned into the Secretarys Office the 29th of May 1738.
