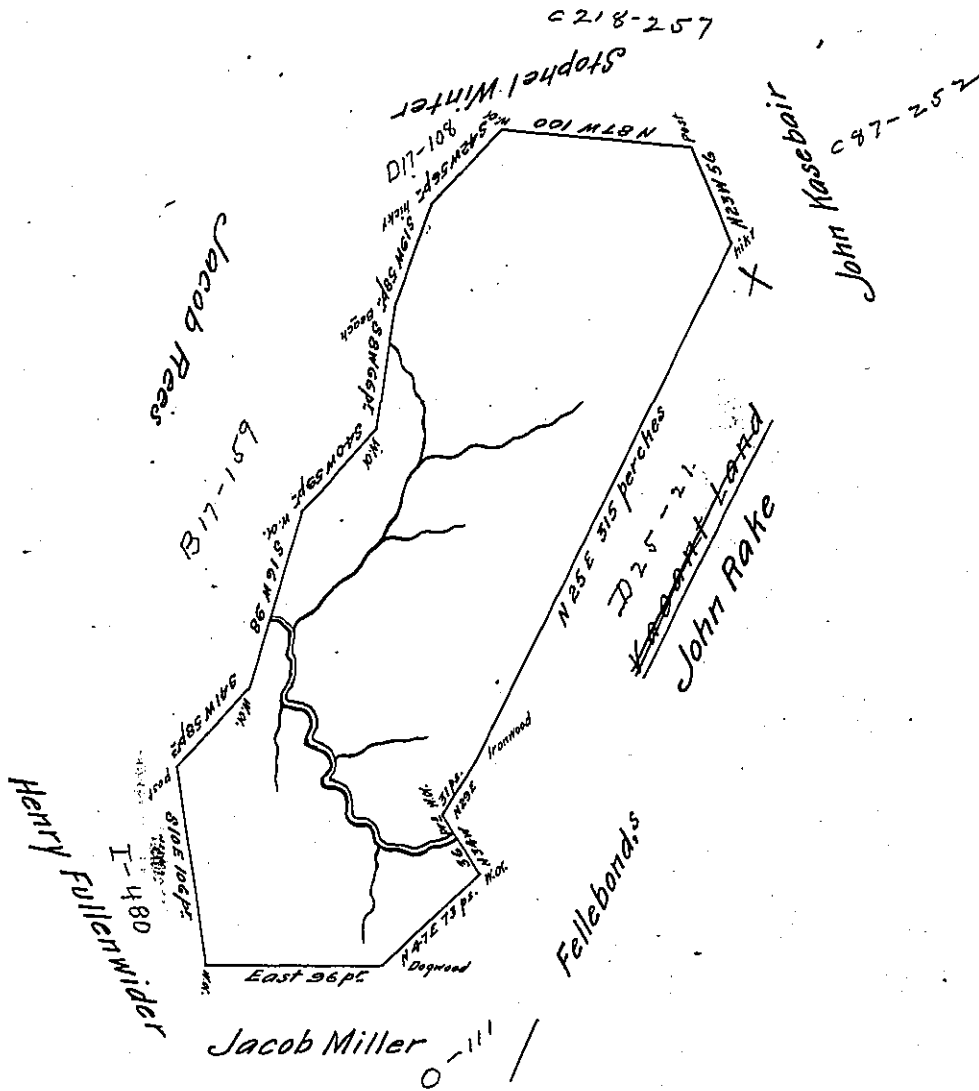

 in preemption to 1000 Acres adjoining thereto
