



Situated in (Cumberland now) Franklin Township Adams County Surveyed January 26th 1805 by Warrant to Mathew Mc Nutt for 180^o. Dated 7th April 1767.

N.B. Upon this warrant the land was claimed, to the original line of Carrols Delight which is supposed to be 50 or 60 perches further in than Gillahans line but as Gillahans line was confirmed by act of Assembly I bounded this on it, therefore part of the land which was intended to be covered by this warrant is excluded, by which there was not land enough to fill the Warrant without taking mountain land which ¹/₂ supposed was not intended by the warrantee.
