



A Draught of part of a larger tract of land situate in Townbury Township in the County of York granted by warrant dated the first day of November 1735 to John Heald, originally surveyed the 4<sup>th</sup> day of November 1735. The Original Draught contains 400<sup>+</sup> & allowance of which the above mentioned seventy seven Acres & 57 perches is a part surveyed and divided off from the whole tract for a town by Eli Lewis the present possessor on the 2<sup>th</sup> day of April 1795.
