



Situate in Manchester Township in the County of York Containing as above set forth 74<sup>1/2</sup> & 141<sup>1/2</sup> & allowance of 6 per Cent & Being part of a larger Tract originally surveyed by George Stephenson late D.D. on the 19<sup>th</sup> of Decem<sup>r</sup> 1725. In pursuance of two warrants for 100<sup>ac</sup> each both Dated the 8<sup>th</sup> Day of May 1742. Granted to Baltzer Knertzner alias Baltzer Knertzner and Resurveyed by the old lines the 28<sup>th</sup> Day of May 1805. & returned & Ctd Divided off the above from the said larger Tract of Land on the 14<sup>th</sup> Day of June 1804. at the request of the present Owner Peter Kern who has now Desired me to make return of the Draught the 11<sup>th</sup> Day of August 1809.
