

This tract interferes Two Acres ^{and one half} with the John Forshee Survey - John Forshee conveyed to Mr Sanders, whose heirs Joshua and Hesekiah Sanders conveyed to Joseph Norris Gen^r who devised the same to Joseph Norris Jr who obtained the aforesaid Warrant and is the present owner

Situate on the west side of the Royston Branch of Juniata in Hopewell Township Huntingdon County containing one hundred and ninety six acres and twenty seven perches and allowance Surveyed the 20th day of April 1830 in order to John Goshe To R. S. dated 15th September 1866
