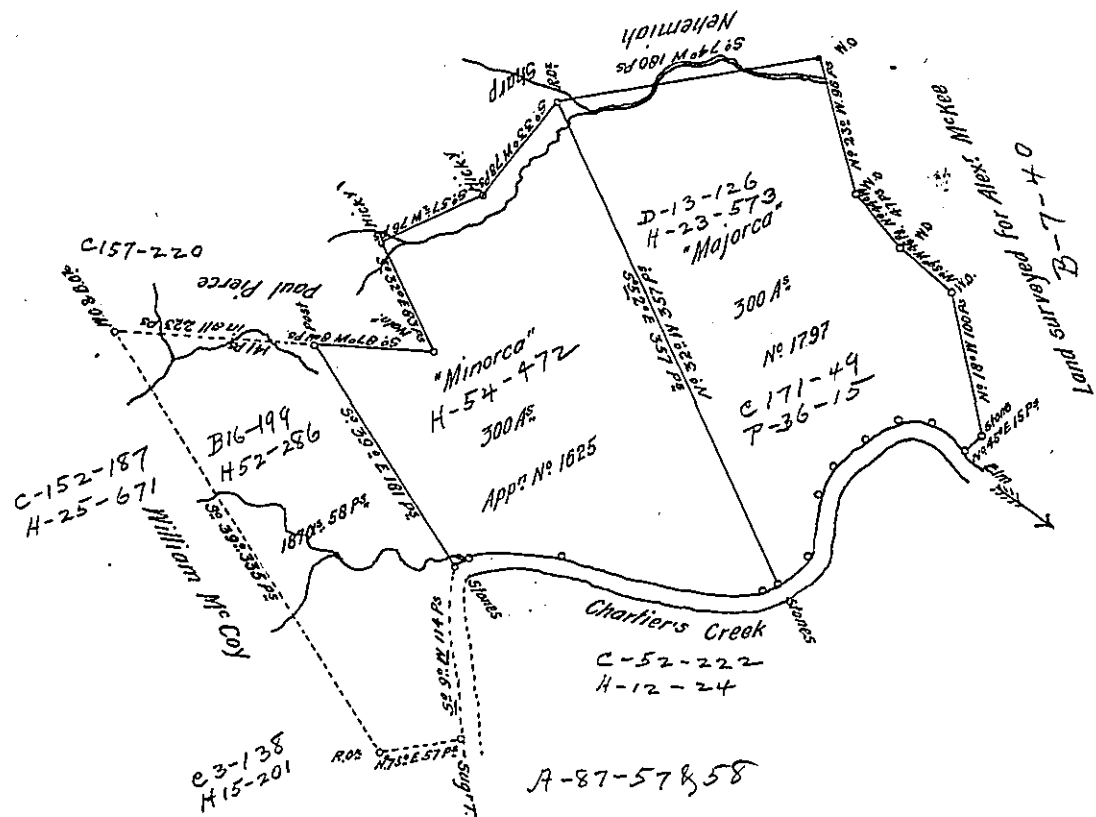

A Draught of two surveys situate on Charliers Creek in Washington, surveyed March the 1st 1787. Minorca containing 300^{acs} and the usual allow^{ce} for Roads &c. on an Order granted to ^{Henry} Barclay for 300 ac. dated Apl. 3rd 1789 &c. 1625. Majorca contain^g 300^{acs} and the usual allow^{ce} on an Order granted to Robert Bailey for 300 ac. dated the 3rd Apl. 1769, &c. 1797. Minorca including 187 ac. 58^{acs} within the dotted lines making in the whole 487 ac. 58^{acs} was surveyed at the same time on a Warrant granted to Col Gen Morgan for 400 ac. dated May 2nd 1785.

Note. These Surveys were returned same time ago, but through Mistake the orders were transposed, and the Division improperly made - tis requested to withdraw those Returns & substitute these in their Place.

Application was made to have this Land surveyed in the Fall of 1785 but the Surveys were not finished (owing to the Claimant not attending to them) till March y^e 1st 1787.
