



Situate in Wassell's Township Adams County Surveyed March 28th 1816 In pursuance of a warrant granted to Michael Oylor for 270^{ac} dated October 10th 1815 Containing two hundred & thirty acres one hundred perches & alls. This and 91^{ac} 124^{per} & alls. Surv^d same day on warrant to David Stewart of same date and 27^{ac} 95^{per} & alls. Surv^d same day on a warrant to Henry Steunor (alias Steunor) of same date were all one tract on which there is an old improvement which from information and its appearance is at least fifty years old and a family now living on it most of it is very hilly & rocky.
