



Situate in Shrewsbury Township York County containing within the black lines as above set forth thirty acres, eighty perches & allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Being part of a larger tract of 219^{ac} 77^{pc} & allowance originally surveyed by William Hatthens late D.D. on the 7th day of the 11th month 1776 in pursuance of a Warrant for 190 acres granted to Michael Kleinfelder, dated the 26th day of February AD 1775 - the above part resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract on the 7th day of May 1811, and now at the request of Abraham Yost the present owner of said part the Draught is examined, corrected, calculated, and returned for confirmation.
