It is part of 166 acres 38 perches & allowance which was resurveyed on the 25th day of November 1812 for the Heirs of Christian Keeener in right  
of Hans Keeener in pursuance of a Warrant dated October 25th 1739 and contains Twentytwo acres and twenty nine perches & the Ell  
and six acres and one hundred and eight perches more.

B is the same tract or piece of land which was resurveyed on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of November 1862 for the heirs of Christian
