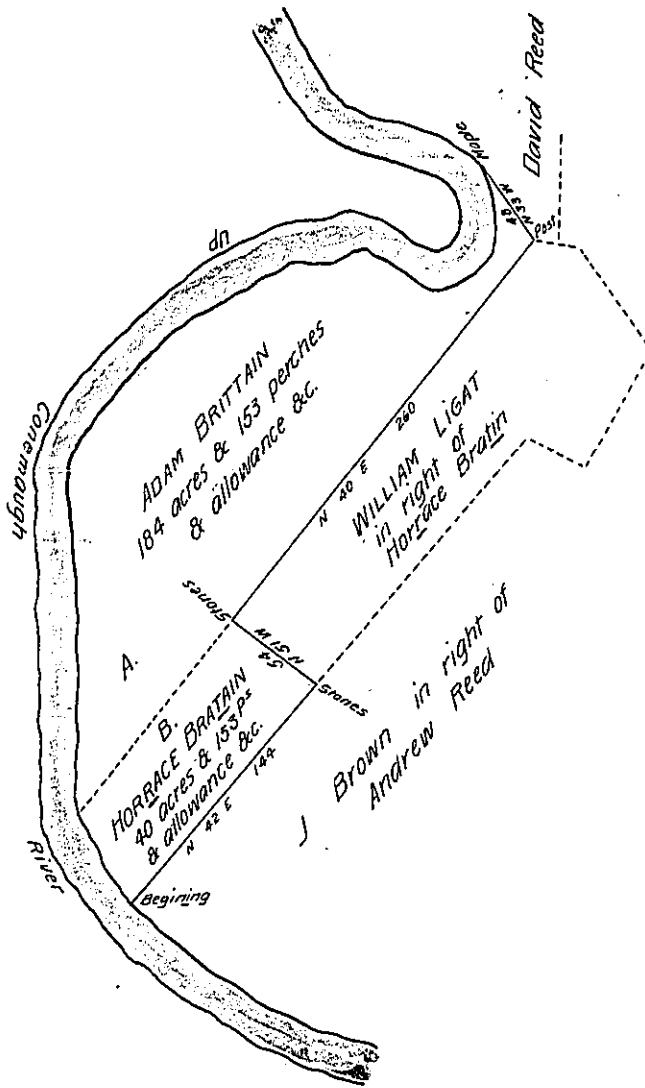

*Surveyed April 12<sup>th</sup> A.D. 1853 to George and Samuel Britain the above described tract of land situate on the North Side of the Conemaugh River in Wheatfield Township Indiana County Containing two hundred and twenty five acres and one hundred and forty four perches and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. Bounded by the Conemaugh River on the South and on the other side as above described*

*That part marked with the letter A containing one hundred and eighty four acres and one hundred and fifty three perches & allowance was surveyed to Adam Britain on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of May 1812 by Warrant dated 19<sup>th</sup> day of Dec. 1785. That part marked with the letter B containing forty acres and one hundred and fifty three perches is part of a larger tract of land surveyed to Horrace Britain on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of July A. D. 1815.*
