


Henry Pratt



A draught of a tract of land situate in Bridgewater Township Surveyed in the name of Joseph Donaldson Jun<sup>r</sup> dated the 24 day of August 1784 Containing 425 acres which interferes upon a Survey made in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Edward Shippen dated the 20 day of August 1774 of 113 acres 74 perches & 2 tenths and allowance of 6 per cent leaving in the said tract of land Surveyed in the name of Joseph Donaldson Jun<sup>r</sup> 311 acres 95 perches & 4 tenths and allowance of 6 per cent Re-surveyed the 25-26 & 27 days of September 1834 for Charles S. Coxe in pursuance of an Order of the Board of Property bearing date the 5 day of September 1834 Also one other piece of land adjoining the above Containing 89 acres 149.6 perches and allowance of 6 per cent.
