



The above is a Draught of Berjⁿ Chew Esq^rs Land on Green Creek with the several interferences— his land is included within the black lines & contains three thousand nine hundred and one acres & 112 perches & allc^e— those interferences in the Names of Joshua Warner Isaac Stroud John Parrock & Wm Hopkins Sen^r & Jun^r are made on Orders of April 1769. But all the others are Warrants dated 16th August 1773. I have blocked a Number of the Corner trees and find them marked nineteen years ago. I had a William Sims on the ground who says he assisted at the Survey & will give a deposition to that effect. This done by Virtue of your Order of resurvey this 21st Sept^m 1792
