



Situate in Conewago (late Dover) Township in the County of York containing as above set forth twelve acres eighty seven perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c^s. Being part of a larger tract of 265^{ac} 101^{ps} and $\frac{1}{2}$ allowance. Originally surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant for 200^{ac} granted to Jacob Doutel (son of Jacob) dated the 23^d day of December A.D. 1788—resurveyed by Jacob Spangler Esq^r late D.S. on the 25th & 26th days of March A.D. 1808. The above part resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract on the 7th day of September 1808 and now at the request of Jacob Hoffman the present owner of said part the same is examined found correct and returned for confirmation
