



The above is a draught of two tracts of land surveyed the 28th day of October 1800 in pursuance of two Certif^s for 400 acres each granted to James McCormick by the Commissioners appointed by Virginia to adjust the Claims to unpatented Lands in the counties of Monong^a Yohg^a & Ohio and duly entered with the County Surveyor &c. - Situate in the county of Washington on Millers Run. No 1. Called Atrna Containing one hundred and sixty acres & one hundred & eight perches Strict measure. No 2. Called Visuvius Containing three hundred & ninety ~~one~~ acres & forty five perches Strict Measure.

NB. the above is a part of the same land surveyed March the 23rd 1787 & Returns thereof made into the Surveyor Generals Office Signed Presley Nevill & Matthew Fitchey D. Sr. which returns Imbraced lands claimed by Jn^o Andrews which claim has since been confirmed to the said Andrews & is excluded from the above
