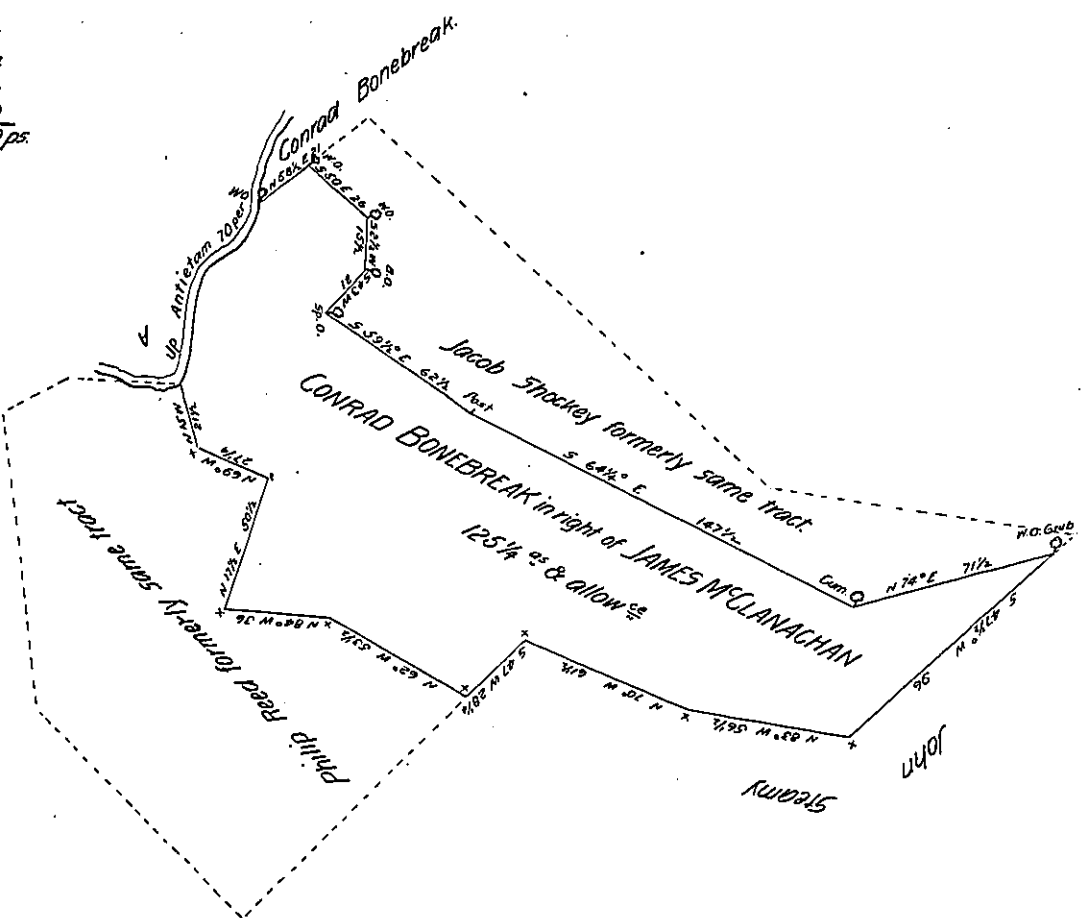

Being a part of a tract of 265 acres 158 perches & allowance surveyed on a Warrant granted to James McClenachan dated June 10th 1762

Resurveyed and laid off from the other parts of the tract June 14th 1810 by Thomas Poe then Deputy Surveyor.

I hereby certify that the above is a true copy of a draught on file in the Surveyors office in & for the county of Franklin (The dotted lines of original tract and the letter A being added by me) which I have examined and find correctly calculated.

Note by J.B. Kaufman. The portion A on west side of creek is included in survey to Casper Hanly & James Scott on Warrants dated May 3^d 1743 & 23^d Aug^t 1751, hence left out by Mr. Poe.
