



Situate in Chancetford township in the County of York, Containing within the black lines as above set forth 45° & 52° and allowance. Being part of a larger tract of 268^{ac} & allowance which was Originally Surveyed by William Matthews late D.S. on the 2^d of the 4th mo. 1770 for Stephen M^cKinly in pursuance of two Warrants, one granted to Richard M^cDonnel for 100^{ac} dated the 22^d day of March 1743, the other granted to David M^cKinly for 50^{ac} dated the 1st day of April 1751. Resurveyed & divided off from the said larger tract of Land at the instance of Daniel Murphey the present owner the 2^d day of April 1821.
