



On the Warrant granted to the Widow Elizabeth Poizer alias Beisher in trust for her seven Children the 10th of December 1788 I have surveyed unto her for the use of the said Children the heirs & representatives of Andrew Beisher dec^d. who was eldest son of Adam Beisher dec^d. the above described tract of one hundred and ten acres of land situate on Tohicon Creek in Bedminster township Bucks County on which is an improvement made the first of December 1768 in which the said widow & Children now lives this 13th day of August 1791.

The Warrant on which this land the 110^{as} was surveyed states that Interest is to commence from the 1st day of December 1768. The owner of the Land however acknowledges that the land was improved at least as early as the year 1744, interest therefore ought to commence from that time.
