



Explanation

A represents the part of the ~~of the of the~~ Jeremiah Stillwell interfering with the warrant to Richard Pittman Senr dated May 11th 1785.

B represents the part of the Jeremiah Stillwell interfering with the warrant to John Reynolds or Rannells dated June 7th 1763.

C represents the part of the Jeremiah Stillwell interfering with the warrant to Jacob Simpson dated September 4th 1793.

These interferences are patented, respectfully, under the Warrants with which they interfere.

The red broken lines delineate the residue of the Jeremiah Stillwell covered by other patents.
