



A Draught of a Piece of Land, situate in Codorus Township, in the County of York, Containing as above set forth 85^{ac} & 123 perches & allowance & c part of 224^{ac} & allowance & c which was originally surveyed on the 25th day of October 1752, by George Stevenson late D.S. in pursuance of a warrant for 100^{ac} granted to John Dingale, bearing date the 18th day of December 1751. Since divided & c. Town on the 28th day of November A.D. 1857, Resurveyed & Calculated the above, at the request of Michael Bentz, the present owner, who requested me to make return of the same for Confirmation.
