



Indiana County Pa.

18<sup>th</sup> January 1856. Surveyed to James Morehead the above described tract including an improvement adjoining & bounded as described by dotted lines in Centre Township containing sixty nine and a half Acres & allowance of six per Cent. for Roads &c. By Warrant of 29<sup>th</sup> December 1855. To D. the warrant was handed to me when I was in the neighborhood of the tract within procured the drafts of the adjoining from the present occupants & proceed to survey as above, but upon examination of the papers in the office I found a part of a paper in a mutilated condition but not altogether unintelligible it is endorsed Westmoreland County James Ramsey & Thomas Campbell Rec<sup>d</sup> and on the face of the draft their names and number of Acres respectively as described in the above Diagram (it leaving out the names of the present occupants) but what renders it mysterious and unsatisfactory is that to the east of the Ramsey & Campbell survey as will appear in the foregoing by the dotted lines A, B. & C. the courses and distances given are N 76 84 E 116 Maple. S 76 T N 88 D. or. S 76 40 W 196 but the aforesaid paper contains no further than to the stroke I have made across the last mentioned line which you will readily perceive interferes with the survey & includes all of this one as much of it as I have including no name or number of Acres. I respectfully submit it to your consideration
