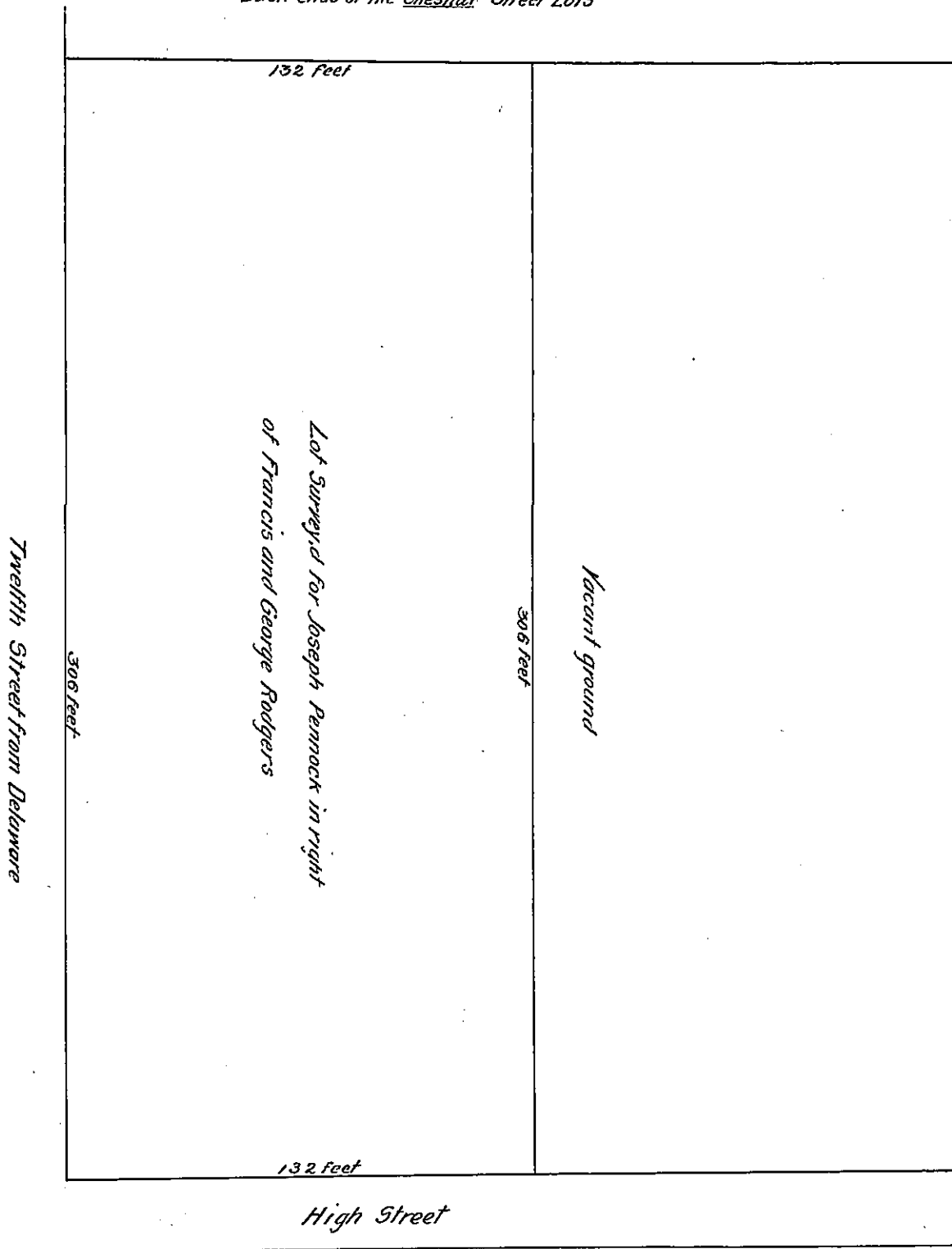


Back ends of the Chestnut Street Lots



Sir Agreeable to your request I have surveyed for Joseph Pennock, a lot situate in the City of Philadelphia, beginning at a stake at the corner of High Street and the 12th Street from Delaware, thence by the sth High Street westward 132 feet, thence southward by Vacant ground 306 feet to the back ends of the Chestnut Street lots, then by those lots eastward 132 feet to the sth 12th Street, thence along the sth Street (on the west side thereof) northwards 306 feet to the place of Beginning
