


A Draught of a Tract of Land situate in Upper Hillford Township in the County of Northampton in the State of Pennsylvania containing one hundred and fifteen acres and 54 perches of Land, and the usual allowance at six per cent for Roads that formerly hath been surveyed, as supposed to Jacob Roush, but the date of the Warrant as now is not known. The said Land hath been divided and sold several times so that at present 47<sup>ac</sup> 27<sup>p</sup> etc thereof is now belonging to Peter Bush, and 58<sup>ac</sup> 64<sup>p</sup> etc to Friedrich Weidman and 29 acres 123<sup>p</sup> etc et allow: in two Tracts thereof to John Kambauer, formerly resurveyed and divided for the said Parties - and now drawn for them on the 12<sup>th</sup> March Anno 1789: -
