Resurveyed by virtue of a special order from the Board, dated the 31<sup>st</sup> day of October 1785. And now, after having been carefully examined, corrected and calculated, I am desired by the owner to return it for confirmation, the 12<sup>th</sup> day of August Anno Domini 1809.
