



In Pursuance of a Warrant dated the 11th day of October 1774, there was surveyed on the 31st day of the same Month, the above described Tract of Three Acres and Twenty One perches and a half of Ground for James Pemberton, Caleb Cresson, Henry Drinker, Charles West, Joseph Bringham & Thomas Fisher on behalf of the Monthly Meetings of Friends in the City of Philadelphia, in Trust for the purpose of a Burial Ground, or any other Religious Use of the said Society. Returned into the Secretaries Office the 23rd day of December 1774.
