



A Draught of two tracts of land situate in the Township of Briar Creek, Columbia County, Penna. together containing two hundred thirty four acres and twenty four perches and allowance of 6% for Roads &c. surveyed for Nelson B. Stackhouse and Mc Dowell Stackhouse the seventh and eighth days of January A.D. 1884, they being part of a larger tract of 510<sup>ac</sup> & allowance (eighty acres and ninety nine perches of this tract lies within the certified Township of Dale, one of the 17 Townships in Luzerne County and released to the Commonwealth by William Smith Grantee of John Parkinson) Originally surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to John Parkinson dated the seventh day of August, A.D. 1785
