



Situates partly in Washington, but principally in Franklin, formerly Kanawhan township, in the county of York, Containing as above set forth, 59 1/2 & 79 1/2 perches and allowance etc. Being part of a larger tract of land which was originally surveyed in pursuance of Daniel Keredy's Application No. 4874, dated the 23rd day of March 1768. Resurveyed and divided off from said larger tract of land the second day of May 1867, and at the request of Aaron B. Felcker, Jacob Lehmer and Michael Wiley, returned for confirmation.
