Surveyed for Sarah H. Patterson, the 17th day of April 1800. It being a part of a larger tract of four hundred & thirteen acres and twenty three perches and allowance. Originally surveyed on a warrant granted to Daniel Pennington, dated the 20th day of July 1792.
