We the Commissioners for Adjusting Claims to unpatented Lands in the Counties of Monongalia, Johogania & Ohio do hereby Certify that Jacob Rice is Entitled to four Hundred Acres of Land in the County of Ohio on Buffalo Creek to include his settlement made in year one thousand seven hundred and seventy three and also a Right in preemption to one thousand acres adjoining thereto. Given under our hands at Cox's Fork the seventh Day of February 1780. in the fourth year of the Commonwealth.
