Variation 3 Degrees West.

Situate in Butler (formerly Keasauale) Township Adams County surveyed the 21<sup>st</sup> day of April AD 1853 for William Tool, containing fifty six acres one hundred & forty two perches & the usual allowance of six per cent for road &c. It being a part of a larger tract said to contain 256 $\frac{3}{4}$  ac & all which was surveyed by Moses McClean D.D. the 16<sup>th</sup> day of Nov. 1791 in pursuance of a Warrant for 200<sup>l</sup> granted to John Hoick-  
ele Dated 30<sup>th</sup> Nov. 1742 (Adjoining Tool Moor & Mrs. Cassens Land on Canawago Creek then Lancaster County
