End in Oxford Township; it includes an Original Survey made by my Father for William Anderson in pursuance of a warrant granted to Robert Stuart Dated 15th August 1738, & by me Resurvey'd in the Year 1757 for 197¹/₂ & allowance; now Resurvey'd at the request of David Junkin it includes also two small Parcels he purchased contiguous hereto the one 10¹/₄ Part of a Tract Survey'd ~~Survey'd~~ for David Hogg by warrant of 13th June 1754, & the other 8² bought of John Gray, Survey'd formerly with other Land for William Evans by warrant of the 13th Feb^y 1749.
