



The above described tract of one hundred and fifty six acres, and forty four perches, of Land & allowance, is part of a larger tract of two hundred and eighty acres & one hundred & thirty four perches, & allowance, situate in Southampton Township, Franklin County, which was surveyed to Lawrence Stumpach the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1768, in pursuance of an Order of Survey dated the 27<sup>th</sup> November 1766, and one other Order of Survey, dated January 20<sup>th</sup> 1767, No. 2485 for 200<sup>ac</sup> Resurveyed, and divided off, the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of March 1805.
