


By order of the Proprietaries surveyed on the sixth Day of April 1736 to John Stewart a tract of Land on Susquehanna River in the Township of Donegal in the County of Lancaster Beginning at a Birch tree by the said River then North 31 deg East 396 ft to Black oak then South 57 deg East 175 ft to Black oak then South 56 deg East 78 ft to birch then South 54 deg West 216 ft to a birch by the said River then up by the said River 229 ft to the Beginning Containing 357 1/2 Acres and the allowance of six pct for Roads & Highways
