In pursuance of a Warrant of Resurvey dated the 15th day of November 1764 granted unto Henry Skiles & others I did on the 21st, 22 & 23 days of May 1765 resurvey the several tracts as therein mentioned possessed by Henry Skiles, the Heirs of Andrew Caldwell deceased, & John Rouse & find to interfere one with another as represented in the annexed plan, the Land patented to Andrew Caldwell by Course & Distance is represented by the yellow lines. - The Land patented to John Rouse by Course & Distance is represented by the Green lines. And the Land surveyed for the said Henry Skiles is shown by the Red lines. But the line of marked trees between the Lands of Caldwell, Rouse & Skiles several of which were boxed & found to have been marked in the year 1733 is in the line from K to Z. -
