



Resurveyed and surveyed on the 7th and 16th days of January A.D. 1854 to Archibald Coleman the two adjoining pieces containing forty six acres and eleven perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c that part marked with the letter C containing twenty three acres and one hundred and forty four perches and allowance of six per cent is a part of a larger tract of land surveyed to John Hochlin on the 18th day of March 1789 in pursuance of a Warrant dated 6th day of Sept 1785 that part marked with the letter B containing twenty two acres and twenty seven perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c was surveyed to the said Archibald Coleman in pursuance of a warrant dated 15th day of January 1854 bounded as above described
