



Situate in Robinson Township Berks County, containing three hundred & thirty five acres & fifty perches & allowance of six per cent for roads & two hundred & twenty four acres, one hundred & fifty five perches & allow. surveyed the 13th March 1811 to Conrad Kocher in right of John Piersoll in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 30th of August 1740. Seventy two acres & seventy perches & allow. surveyed the same day to Conrad Kocher in right of Michael Walker in pursuance of a warrant dated the 23rd of November 1758. & thirty seven acres, one hundred & forty five perches & allow. surveyed the same day to Conrad Kocher in right of Christian Harcourt in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 30th of September 1757.
