Being part of a larger tract of 227^{1/2} and the usual allowance of Land which was originally surveyed by Thomas Curnor late D.D. under George Stevenson late D.D. on the 23^d day of February A.D. 1755. In Pursuance of a warrant granted to Jacob Pop bearing date the 17th day of November A.D. 1752. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract of Land for and at the request of the owner Joseph White who desired the same to be Restored for Confirmation Resurveyed & Divided as aforesaid the 22^d day of March A.D. 1815
