In Pursuance of an Order of the Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Board of Property of the 7<sup>th</sup> April 1788 we viewed the Land in Dispute between Henry Snively & Robert Davison in Antrim Township Franklin County examining the Lines, whereupon we find ~~that~~ by the location of the Warrant for 50 Acres granted to Jacob Snively "adjoining John Nigh and his other Land" Dated the twelfth of May 1763 was intended to include a Part of the Survey of 128 Acres which has been Survey'd & Return'd to Robert Davison on a 50<sup>ac</sup> Warrt. Dated the 16<sup>th</sup> May 1763, which appears also to be corroborated by the Testimony of Barbara Snively now taken ~~at~~, who says upon Oath duly taken that she herself made Application & took the sd Warrant in the Name of Jacob Snively her late Husband deceased, intending the same for the very Land now in Dispute, and further saith that she is now way interested in this Dispute — Henry Snively claims the 50 Acres & 99<sup>ft</sup> mark'd off above by the dotted Line Part of the 128<sup>ac</sup> Survey aforesaid, having upwards of 70<sup>ac</sup> remaining to said Survey — an Error having been committed in that Survey in the Line adjoining John Nigh which reduces the Quantity of the whole upwards of 6 Acres.
