



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Marlborough Township in the County of Montgomery in the State of Pennsylvania, which By Warrant dated the ^{11th} November Anno 1736 was Surveyed to Simon Moge, late deceased, who was the Father in Law to Christian Sheit to whom the said Tract of Land is now belonging. --- Beginning at a Stone, in the Line of the Said Christian Sheit's other Land, thence by the Same, and by Land of John Saladin, North West 73 perches to a Stone in the Line of Mathias Sheiffely's Land thence by the Same North East 34 perches to a Stone, and North 32 degrees East 50 perches to a Stone --- And North West 30 perches to a white oak, thence by the Same, and by Land of Samuel Shuler (formerly Christopher Newman's) North East 102 perches to a Stone in the Line of Nicholas Wolfarth's Land --- Thence by the Same and by Land of Jacob Sheaffer (late Henry Norbeck) South East 114 perches to a Stone in the Line of the Said Jacob Sheaffer's other Land thence by the Same South West 185 perches to the Place of Beginning, Containing One hundred and five Acres and and 140 Perches of Land, together with the usual Allowance at Six per Cent for Roads, - Or 112 Acres and 36 Perches Strict. Surveyed for the Said Christian Sheit on the 11th April Anno 1786
