



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Maccongy Township in the County of Northampton and Province of Pennsylvania Containing Thirty Six Acres and 22 Perches of Land together with the usual allowance at Six per Cent for Roads — That was surveyed on the 11th November 1762 By order of James Scull Dep^t Surveyor unto Philip Sharry (al. Sherer) In Pursuance of a Warrant granted to him by the Hon^{ble} Proprietaries Dated the 25th October Anno 1757. — He the said Philip Sherer (al. Sheirer.) By his Deed Poll dated the 29th November 1766 Sold and conveyed his Right to the same to Adam Desh who again by his Deed Poll dated May 24th 1766 Sold and Conveyed the same to Jacob Shankweiler (al. Shankwieler.) who being the present Possessor — — — But by some unusual Mistake a quite wrong Date of the Warrant (being Sept 28th 1765) is mentioned in the said Two Deed Polls. Now Drawn again for the said Jacob Shankweiler on the 5th June Anno 1773. —
