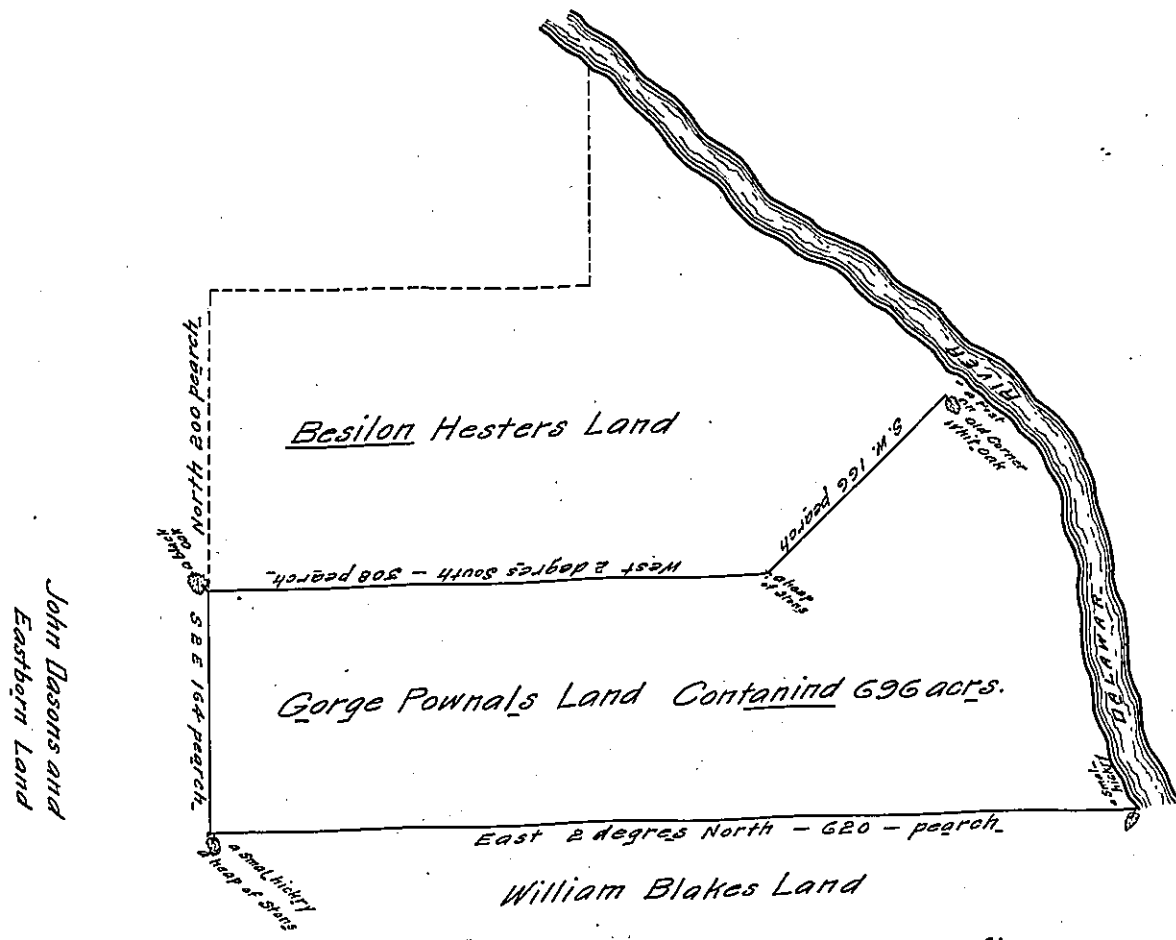

 vey then South west one hundred and Sixty six perch to a heap of stons then West two degrees
 South acording to my Compes three hundred and eight pearches by the land of Besialan Hester Land
 to a black oake marked for a corner then South 2° East one hundred Sixty fower perch to a heap
 of stons by John Dasons Land and Eastborns land then then East 2 degrees north Six hundred
 and twenty perch to a smal hickry by the Land of William Blakes Standing by the sid of
 Dalawar River then upp the severl courses of the saim to the place of begining Containind
 Six hundred ^{and ninety six acrs} ~~acres~~ Resurveyed on the 6 of the 6 month 1741
