



Situate in West Penn Township, Schuylkill County, Containing 167^A 98^{1/2} P^s & Allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. Surveyed originally unto George Schellhammer (by virtue of his Warrant granted to him, dated the 18th day of September A.D. 1767.) It appears by the date of the blocks from the line trees, that the survey was made in the latter end of the year 1768, or in the beginning of the year 1769, - no Original Draught, with the date of the survey, is, so far as I can find out, now in existence. The Warrant issued for land in Northampton County - Surveyed February 25th A.D. 1828
