Surveyed the 17th day of June Ad 1824 for Daniel Shoemaker in Persuance of a Warrant bearing date the 27th day of April Ad 1824 Containing ninety four acres and one hundred and thirty three Perches and allowance of Six ^{1/2} Cent for roads.
