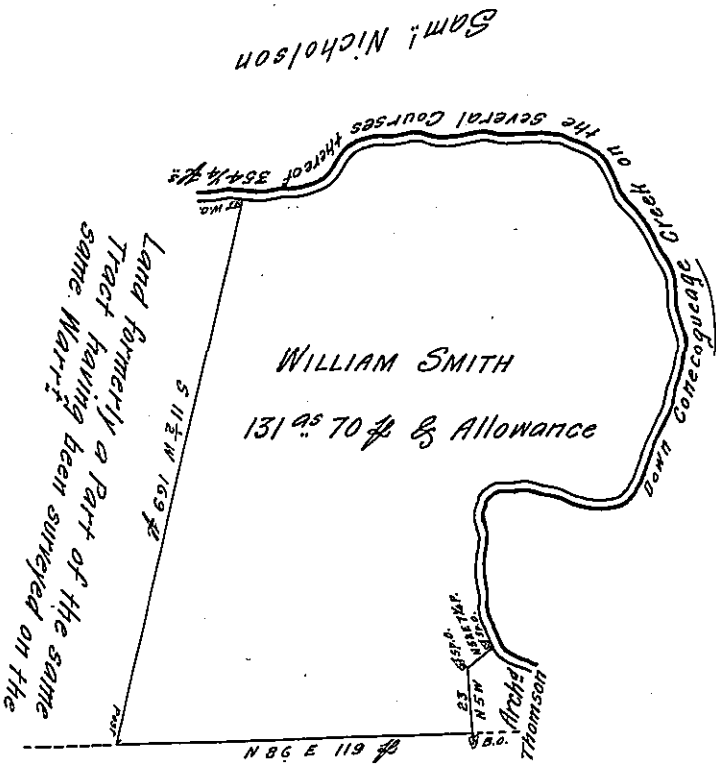

A Draft of a Tract or Parcel of Land situate formerly in Letterkenny Township in the County of Cumberland, but now in Green Township in the County of Franklin Containing One Hundred and thirty one Acres and seventy Perches and the Allowance of Six ff Cent for Roads &c being Part of a Tract formerly survey'd in pursuance of a Warrant granted to William Smith bearing Date the 12th Day of August 1765. Resurveyed and laid off the 31st Day of May 1792.
