B. Represents a draught of 263⁹⁵ 73 perches and the allowance of six per cent for roads &c Surveyed to John & William M^c Dowell 10th day of Nov. 1801 In pursuance of their warrant bearing date 26th March 1801 ~

A. Shews an interference with a Survey made for W^m Brown 20th June 1767 on Appⁿ dated August 1st 1766 N^o 606 & said to contain 297 1/4 acres and the allowance ~

 The House represents the one built on the land (built) by Robert Orr at the time that he obtained his warrant for 50 acres bearing date 27th Nov. 1771 I cannot find any survey that was made to Orr but I have ascertained on the ground by old residents the place where the house stood ~ and it must have covered the land granted to G. Erwin.



I have not been able to find any notes draughts or any other papers in this office that would go to shew that there has been any survey made for Gawin Erwin on Appⁿ dated 27th Nov. 1766 N^o 1991 but owing to the survey made for William Wilson 18th May 1787 by Jas. Harris without him having reference to some warrant or order of survey I am led to believe that it was made on Gawin Erwin's Application.
