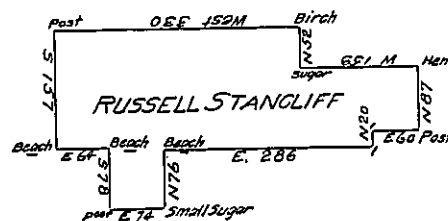


Anson Godard Land

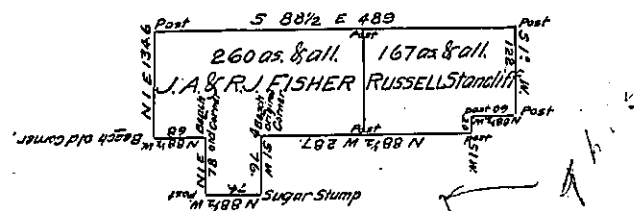
